CERTIFICATION AND REGISTRATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL EXPERTS

1. The National Environment Management Council (NEMC) is a body corporate established by the Environmental Management Act No. 20 of 2004 to undertake enforcement, compliance, review and monitoring of environmental impact assessments, environmental research, raising environmental awareness and collecting and disseminating environmental information.
2. The EMA, 2004 requires that Environmental Impact Assessments and Environmental Audits be conducted by experts or firms of experts whose names and qualifications are registered as such by the Council. The Council maintains a register of the experts and firms of experts.
3. The Council hereby invites eligible and qualified members of the public to apply for certification and registration as environmental experts. Application by firms wishing to register as 'firms of environmental experts' under the Environmental (Regulation of Environmental Experts) Regulation, 2005 will be invited after the certification and registration of individual experts has been completed. This is because firms of experts are required to have, within their members, at least one certified and registered environmental expert.
4. Applications should be submitted to NEMC through filling in a Form to be obtained, at a fee, from the office of the Registrar of Environmental Experts. Where a person intends to apply to conduct both an environmental impact study and an environmental audit, two separate applications shall be submitted.
5. Applicants should:
 - (i) Possess at least a first degree in a relevant discipline or its equivalent from an accredited University or Institution.
 - (ii) Have knowledge in environmental management in general and competence in carrying out environmental impact assessment and/or environmental auditing. Training and experience in Environmental Impact Assessment will be added advantages.
 - (iii) Provide names of at least three referees who are conversant with environmental issues and particularly Environmental Impact Assessment practice.
